- This group is looking to review electrification activity for EMM that involve replacing the diesel engine, powering earthmoving equipment as defined in ISO 6165, with a battery(s) and electrical components i.e., Traction motors, electric actuators, electric pumps etc., and how those activities impact standards that support the EMM industry.
