Meeting participants are not allowed to use artificial intelligence software to take notes, record, transcribe, or reproduce any of the information shared during an official AEM meeting. As the trade association representatives, AEM staff are the only meeting attendees that are allowed to record the meeting for the purpose of taking notes and ensuring the meeting minutes are accurate. AEM asks that members refrain from using AI to record meetings or take notes.
